Description of Change (To) :





Marking content is marked with alpha numeric for date code (year and work week) and plant code. Date code type is S2 for MLP, uPak MLP and uMLP. Incorporate Lot Trace Code.

Remark: During transition period, there will be shipment of old and new part in same time frame until all old part finish shipped. Estimate last shipment of old part is Pd 06 2014.

Reason for Change:

1. Notification on new implementation date for P233A on WW47.
2. ION for part not cover in P233A (21 parts).
